Be Like Brit Orphanage Opens!

Britney Gengel was a young woman from Rutland, Massachusetts. Brit and her classmates from Lynn University arrived in Haiti the day before the earthquake that killed more than 200,000 people. They spent the day talking with young children, orphans they had traveled so far to help. Just a few hours later, Britney, three of her fellow students, and two of their professors were dead. Britney was only 19 years old. But Britney's dream did not die with her. In her honor, her family has been raising money to build an orphanage in Haiti.
