## **Kicking Off Year Two (Year Two Hundred Ninety-Nine)**

Nathaniel Sparhawk was ordained here on August 17, 1720. I hope you are looking forward as much as I am to our Three Hundredth Anniversary year and all the discoveries and celebration it will hold. Stay tuned for a call to participate in the planning, which will begin this year. But in the meantime, we are off to a great start of our new program year. On Sunday we gathered again as a whole church in our beautiful sanctuary. We blessed backpacks and work bags. We reminded our children and ourselves of our identity as bearers of the good news. We sent the children off to three different, age-specific programs to meet their teachers and get acclimated (or re-acclimated) to their classroom environment and to each other. And of course, we shared a time of fellowship with one another.

This fall, as we continue to explore and imagine the ways that Centre Church is called to serve in Lynnfield and beyond, we will be highlighting more of the ongoing ministries that Centre Church has been involved with year in and year out. And our children will be spending time on the first Sunday of each month learning about worship and sacraments. We hope as we live and learn about our worship and our service together as the Body of Christ you will reflect, discern, and grow in your own faith and service. Perhaps you've been coming here your whole life and

you've done the same thing(s) for a long time. Maybe it's time to try something new! If you're new to Centre Church, we hope that you will discover ways in which your gifts and your time can be shared. What I know for sure is that each and every single one of us, from the most mature to the littlest among us, has been given gifts to share toward the building of God's kin-dom here on earth. And not one of us is ever called to take it all upon ourselves! You are not God, and neither am I! Lazarus House, located in Lawrence MA, provides food, clothing, shelter and work preparation for people dealing with poverty and homelessness in the Merrimack Valley. They are sponsoring a 5K fundraising walk called the "Hike for Hope" on Sunday, Sept. 30, starting at 1pm (after church!). Funds raised will provide life-saving basic services to people in crisis as well as life-changing transitional housing, education, and vocational training to help people build more stable lives for themselves and their families. Registration begins at 11:30 a.m., and the walk starts at 1 p.m. at The Park on Bartlet Street in Andover. Rev. ### Faith Formation is a Lifelong Journey

Here at Centre Church, we not only offer Church School for our children and youth, we have opportunities beyond worship and service for you to enrich your faith journey as well.

**Bible Study** – On Thursday afternoons at 1:00 pm in the library, an adult Bible Study is held. EVERYONE is welcome and aside from our consistent core group, we had several people join us for a session or two. Together we decide our next focus of study. For the month of September we are reading the Book of Proverbs, one chapter per day. In October we will begin a study of the Gospel of John. All are welcome!

**Faith Formation Certification Course** – On the morning of Saturday, October 6, Rev. Dr. Mary Luti will be here at Centre Church teaching a class on worship and sacraments. This course is open to all but must be registered for in advance through the MACUCC. It will be offered again in January in Northampton and have a video-conferencing option. If you are interested in learning more about why we “do what we do” in worship, including the Sacraments of Baptism and Holy Communion, you cannot learn from a more qualified or engaging teacher than Rev.
