I'm grateful for Barbara and Susan and their graceful and competent presence, handling all the business of the church. I thank God for Care Team's ongoing support for not only me and my family but for many, many others in our congregation! Our Board of Deacons and our ushers who were welcoming and supportive to our guest preachers Andrew, Douglas, and Donna – and while we're at it, I thank them all for sharing their ministerial gifts and leadership with all of you. And how blessed we are that Rev. Glenn Mortimer was available to lead Centre Church and Edith Wendt's family through the celebration of her life. I am also grateful for the Tower Day staff who blessed us with a delicious batch of the best cure for whatever ails us: chicken soup!

Here we are in Holy Week! Several of our beloved members have died and I'm presented with not just Easter morning, but other opportunities to preach the Good News of the resurrection to new life in Christ Jesus. As we all move through the joys and sorrows that are woven through our lives, our faith, the assurance that we are not alone, and the truth that we come from Love and die into eternal Love becomes the source of our ever more precious hope. The knowledge that joy and sorrow are inextricably linked is never more apparent than during Holy Week when we accompany Jesus all the way to the cross, the tomb, and beyond into resurrected life. My hope is that each of us wake up on Easter morning and think, "Wait. What?" when we contemplate the gift we've been given in Christ Jesus! How blessed we are.
