Summer Church School: Love Overflowing!



As summer approaches and people begin to travel, it is common for our congregation to shrink in numbers. Thus, we provide a simple "All Ages" format during the summer. When classes combine and cover a wider age range, it can be a

challenge to keep all ages interested and involved. While we use a single lesson outline and format, we are also very aware that all of the children have different needs. On Sundays when the weather is good we might decide to take a "movement break" and go out on to the playground.

Our theme this Summer is "Love Overflowing". The passages we have chosen for focus during the summer all speak about love overflowing – God's love for us, our love and thanksgiving to God, love and compassion shown to the poor and needy, and "love without limit" as Paul reminds us that there is no difference between Jew and Gentile, slave and free or any person, regardless of their gender. We are ALL God's children. In our logo, God's love is symbolized in the glorious gift of water, being received by all God's children, and passed on to the flowers and offered to others. The joy and thanksgiving for this gift is so obvious on the faces of the children. During this unit we will read stories of God's overflowing love demonstrated in healing and restoration.

We hope that parents and others will each sign up to help one summer Sunday. Story and materials and activities are provided, so don't be afraid to sign up! The Institute serves persons of all backgrounds and is committed to an integrated approach that serves the whole person including the individual's values that give purpose and meaning to life. With the retirement of Laurence Heckscher, LPP, LMHC from active practice with NEPI, a new counselor was needed to staff the NEPI office here at Centre Church. To that end, Victoria Torres-Vega, LICSW, has begun seeing clients here and is dividing her time between the Salem and Lynnfield offices.

Victoria Torres-Vega, LICSW, graduated with her master's degree in Social Work from Boston College School of Social Work, and is independently licensed in the state of Massachusetts. As a psychotherapist, Victoria specializes in working with families, adolescents, and children who may be experiencing or have experienced depression, anxiety, identity issues, and trauma. She also works with adults who suffer with persistent mental illness.
