August 26, 2019

At this time last year, Mike and I were still getting settled in our new home in Andover and I wrote about milestones in life. And this year, we have just passed yet another huge milestone. Our youngest, our daughter Colleen, has just moved across the country - to the "wrong" coast - to Seattle to begin her life and work as a physical therapist. I was so very fortunate to drive with her across 13 states in 7 days! What an amazing journey! More on that another time. As for milestones, here Mike and I are, settling into this new thing, this new time, this new way of being. Not only are we now true "empty-nesters," but we are adjusting to the reality that one of our kids lives a day's travel away and a three-hour time difference. In my Mama's heart I feel the push and pull of pride and longing! I am forever grateful that we live in the era of communication that we do. She doesn't feel nearly so far away when we can talk, video chat, and text whenever we want. But the truth still remains that life is different now. Our house echoes again with some of that emptiness. But what I'm trying to resist is the urge to fill up that emptiness too quickly. In this age of instant gratification, we too often (I too often) try to fill up any emptiness we feel. Fill a moment of silence with a word, fill 5 minutes of waiting with mindless social media, fill a moment of sadness with online shopping. Instead, I'm trying to cultivate my ability to wait; to sit with the emptiness. To wonder about it. To ask what it might be trying to teach me. To truly imagine what life-giving, soul-filling, long-lasting force could fill it up.

Whenever we reach milestones, whether ones we have set for ourselves or ones we stumble upon, we are presented with an opportunity for reordering our lives; even just a little bit. But in order to go about that reordering, we benefit from a period of reflection on what was and where we have been and a spirit of openness, patience, and imagination about what can be. When we rush through this process, it is more likely that we will find ourselves continually unhappy, unsettled, and unsure. The more we rush, the less likely we are to invite God into our discernment about what's next. If we can open a space for silence and wondering in ourselves, we open a space in which the Holy Spirit can move, inspire, and fill us. In that space and silence, we can look at possibilities, turn them around, look at them from all angles, and imagine what might actually fit into that empty space, that new beginning, that re-ordered life that lies beyond the threshold of this milestone.

As you face whatever milestones you are approaching or have just stumbled over, I hope for you time and space to allow the Spirit to inspire.
