Welcome/Welcome Back

I love fall! Well, to be clear I love fall, except that each year it seems to get here before I'm ready. A few more beach days would be nice. But, here we are! So, let's embrace the present moment and also look forward to what's coming up in the months ahead.

We have great plans shaping up for worship, faith formation, and mission as we enter our 300th year. We'll begin on Welcome/Welcome Back Sunday, September 15th and bless all of our backpacks, work bags, hiking packs, etc. as we all celebrate new beginnings. Our Church School program year begins and we welcome/welcome back our teachers, assistants, and volunteers who shepherd, teach, and care for our children.



This fall we will explore what happens when our world falls apart through a worship series titled: *Unraveled: Seeking God When Our Plans Fall Apart.* We'll explore what becomes of us when our identity – or the path we've been on – comes undone or takes an unexpected detour. We'll wonder what blessings the process of unraveling holds for us individually and communally. Where does God meet us in the spiraling? How is God unraveling our plans, and us, into something new?

On the first Sundays of each month this year our children's all ages curriculum will be focusing on Creation Justice. They'll be learning about God's call to humanity to care for all of creation. We'll include adults in the learning as well. Stay tuned for details

about a "Centre Church Reads" book discussion on Rev. Jim Antal's *Climate Church, Climate World*.

We'll also be active in our community through a variety of events. On September 11, we'll be present at First Responders Day activities on the Common. On September 22, we'll gather for the first Deacon's Breakfast of the year before worship. After worship we'll convene our Annual Meeting to conduct the business of the church. And then in the evening, we'll join with others from Lynnfield for a Night of Hope, shining a light of hope for those recovering from substance use. In October, Larainne and I will attend Mental Health First Aid Training with clergy and laity from our wider faith community. We will once again host the Lynnfield Moms Group for their Trunk or Treat event in our parking lot on Saturday, October 26. On Saturday, November 2, we'll welcome the community into Centre Church for our Holiday Fair and Festival of Trees. And on Sunday, November 24 we'll host an Interfaith Thanksgiving worship service.

This fall also finds us creating a new Middle School Youth Group. The first meeting will be Sunday, October 20th at 5:30 p.m. Larainne has reached out to our ecumenical partners as we seek to engage children in grade 5 and above with opportunities for service, fellowship, and learning. Throughout the season, our choir will be making a joyful noise. If you like to sing, I hope you will consider adding your voice and finding the blessings of fun and fellowship with the choir. Also, our long-standing ministries to Bread and Roses and Haven from Hunger will continue feeding the hungry. Our

building will continue to host many groups. The NEPI counseling office will continue blossoming as a blessed resource to those in need from our community. And Tower Day School will keep our building full of life and joy!

Church School 2019 – 2020:

On the 22nd, we will have an information table at the Deacon's Breakfast.

<u>Welcome Back Sunday:</u> September 15th is "Welcome Back Sunday" and our first day of Church School for the 19-20 year. We invite all children (and adults!) to bring their backpacks, briefcases, work bags or hiking packs to be blessed during our mini message.

Church School Assistant(s)/Volunteers: We are in need of a few more folks to assist our teachers in the Church School classrooms. We are specifically looking for someone to help Ms. Allison with our preschool classroom, Footprints. Having a second adult present is critical for meeting the diverse needs of our children and to comply with best safe church practices. This position doesn't involve any planning, just come & enjoy!
