

Parish Council Minutes – April 19, 2022

Moderator Bruce Weaver called the meeting to order at 7:01 P.M. In attendance on Zoom: Bruce Weaver, Rev. Nancy Rottman, Chuck Cotting, Debbie Cotting, Katherine Decker, Linda Ladd, Jeff Law, Jim Marshall, Annmarie Pendola, Scott DeSantis, and Larainne Wilson. Jim offered the meditation. Minutes from the March 29 meeting were approved by unanimous consent.

Financial Reports: Treasurer Jeff Law provided Council with an update regarding the church's financial situation.

Education: Larainne reported on the activities of Faith Formation. Christine Marshall has been hired for the Nursery Attendant position. All ages are invited to Richardson's on Sunday, April 24 following worship and meeting for ice cream and mini golf. Children's Sunday will be Sunday, June 12th.

Stewardship: Debbie Cotting reported that preparations are underway for the Stewardship Campaign. It will run from May 1 to May 22.

Finance: Chuck Cotting reported about the various maintenance projects and fundraisers. A big thank you to Scott for replacing another failed window in Room 24. We received a donation of a custom-built seven-foot bench that was unneeded by a customer from Jerry's Upholstery and Home Decorating. A big thank you to Jerry's for their donation. We had a successful two-day fundraiser (Mar 24 and Mar 31) with Anthony's Coal Fired Pizza. The next fundraiser will be the Spring Flea Market and Bake Sale on Saturday, May 14th. Following that, the Golf Tournament at The Thomson Club will be on Monday, June 27th.
