#### **Practicing for Easter**

I've been thinking about Easter this year given that we have had so much snow and I look forward to the Easter Sunrise Service in **Newhall Park, Lynnfield.** So, last Saturday I went to Newhall Park and this is what I saw, snow covered fields and a sun that seemed to be blocked by the acrimonious (or unrelenting) nature of our winter. On the positive side, I could easily walk across the snow to the opposite end of the field where we have our sunrise service.



Yesterday, March 22<sup>nd</sup>, I saw a different sun, rising in the east, off the deck of my house. There were no blocking forces except the screen in my doorway. It was clear to

me, that this sunrise was practicing for Easter and surely, knew what it was doing!

#### Are you practicing for Easter?

The disciples and followers of Jesus were not prepared for the first Easter. While Jesus had tried to explain something of it to them in advance, they didn't comprehend. God is preparing for our Easters even if we are not. God is always looking to give us new life, even when we are not looking to receive it. It is my experience that we are often more inclined to think and talk about what is wrong with our lives, with our businesses, our world, our communities, our schools, our politics, and our churches, than we are inclined to think and talk about what is good and blessed.

The blessings spoken of were like a cup overflowing! People shared about the welcoming and accepting nature of our congregation, the blessings of serving on Mission Trip experiences, the blessings of our Christian Education and Youth Group Ministries, the blessings of our Music Ministry, etc. Each person who shared of their blessings, received a helium filled balloon because such sharing lifts all of us up!

One parishioner spoke to me afterward saying she wanted to get up and give thanks for the blessings of our Prayer Ministry because it has touched her and a member of her family, personally.

Speaking for myself, I think sometimes I miss the opportunities to recognize the new life that God is preparing for me because I'm too busy doing what I think is important, instead of spending time asking God to fill me with the new life, and to fill me with the more important plans God is making for me and the church. Perhaps I spend too much time analyzing, calculating, and trying to get my work done, instead of being open to the Spirit and the Easters God gives to me.

Perhaps, though, I am ahead of myself. I say this because before there was Easter, Jesus had to endure the suffering of denial, betrayal, arrest, trial, torture, crucifixion, and death. I wonder what in me and in us needs to die before we can be ready for what the Easter God desires for us? Are there old ways that must go before the new ways God intends can be discovered and celebrated?

#### I invite you to join me as we ponder these things:

**Palm Sunday, March 29<sup>th</sup>, 10 am**, as we share Holy Communion and celebrate Jesus' journey into Jerusalem on a humble donkey, symbolic of his humble and life-giving nature. The children will hand out palms to aid us in our celebrations of Jesus.

**Maundy Thursday, April 2<sup>nd</sup>, 7:30 pm,** in our Sanctuary, to ponder these things of the journey of Jesus to the Cross, and how it relates to our own personal and corporate journeys. We will share Holy Communion and the Office of the Tenebrae, reading and hearing the scriptures depicting Jesus' journey to the grave.

#### Easter Sunday:

**6 AM Easter Sunrise Service**, Newhall Park, Oak Street, Lynnfield, followed by breakfast at Red's, 131 Newbury Street, route 1 north, Peabody. In the event of rain, we will meet in the Meeting House, Lynnfield Town Common.

**10 AM Easter Sunday Service**, Centre Church, 10 AM, featuring our Choir's beautiful cantata, "Kingdom, Power, Glory."

I hope that we are ready for the Easters Jesus brings our way, the birth of children, grandchildren, new opportunities, the blessings of each and every day, friendships that make life joyful, and unexpected, grace-filled moments. May we welcome them. Let us be careful not to destroy them with negativity and futility.

Let us allow God to lead us through the sorrows and challenges to the resurrection Christ brings.
