An Invitation to Deeper Spiritual Experience

There are many ways to nourish our faith as we move through life. I believe that worship is the heart of faith formation because, as the body of Christ in the world, it is important that we consistently gather to affirm our interconnectedness and interdependence and praise our God who created us out of Love and for relationship. Spending an hour each week in worship together is a point of orientation, or perhaps more clearly re-orientation, of our lives toward God that grounds our whole week and provides the spiritual energy to be in a world that often tempts us away from love of God and love of neighbor.

For many of us, however, an hour per week is not nearly enough time to help us feel grounded, centered, connected. Some of you have a daily spiritual practice and I have begun sharing some tools you can use toward finding one if you are searching. We will continue to explore together in the months ahead. But not all faith forming, spiritual experience outside of worship needs to be a solitary endeavor. Here at Centre Church we have some opportunities I'd like to invite you to take advantage of. The first is our weekly Bible Study. A small group meets regularly on Thursday afternoons at 1 pm here at the church. We are currently walking through Lent with the UCC Lenten Devotional providing some thought provoking reflections and inspiring our conversation and exploration together. New participants are always welcome. When Lent is over, we will decide together what will inspire our

study of the Bible together, which has ranged from a series on the history of the Bible to exploring the lectionary text that I will preach on the coming Sunday. If you have time during the day, I hope you'll consider joining us!

For those of you who need an evening opportunity, during Lent I will be offering a midweek worship experience on Wednesday evenings at 7 pm in the Chapel. Using a series called "Sensing the Gospel" created by Matt Skinner, Professor of New Testament at Luther Seminary, we'll explore how we encounter God and God's salvation in embodied ways. I invite you to come, taste (hear, smell, touch), and see! Please come as you are, knowing that whoever and however many of us gather will be just right in the eyes of God.

Love of family and tradition are center-stage but it's not all good as the events of 9/11 create fear and misunderstandings that are hard to even hear about. The performance was followed by a talk-back dialog with the obviously interfaith audience. Rohina is presenting *Unveiled* at colleges, high schools and theaters in hopes of increasing communication and understanding among people around the entire United States.
