Labyrinth

I am thrilled to announce that our labyrinth has arrived. At September's meeting, Parish Council approved the purchase of a portable canvas labyrinth for use here at Centre Church. For those of you who have never walked a labyrinth, I am excited to introduce you to this beautiful spiritual practice. For those of you who have experienced a labyrinth before, I am grateful we can offer new opportunities to deepen your practice.

A labyrinth is an ancient symbol that relates to wholeness. It combines the imagery of the circle and the spiral into a meandering but purposeful path. The labyrinth represents a journey to our own center and back again out into the world. Labyrinths have long been used to enhance prayer and meditative practice. During Advent, the season of waiting, our journey on the labyrinth allows us to contemplate the One who we're waiting for and the hope, peace, joy, and love that cannot wait. Labyrinth walking allows us to engage our whole bodies in prayer. It is sometimes referred to as "praying with our feet."

Our labyrinth will be available in the Narthex on each of the three Wednesday evenings during Advent (December 4, 11, 18) and before, during, and after our Blue Christmas service on December 8 at 5 pm. Everyone is invited! Please make sure you have socks on or with you for your walk. No experience necessary. Just come with your curiosity.
