### **The Gift of Liminal Space**

Well Church, here we are in the In-between; the time between "what was" and "what will be," known in spiritual terms as "liminal space." Richard Rohr describes this place/time in this way, "Liminal space is an inner state and sometimes an outer situation where we can begin to think and act in new ways. It is where we are betwixt and between, having left one room or stage of life but not yet entered the next." We all pass through liminal space over and over again as individuals, but also, as we are now doing, as a world, as a society, as a nation, as the Church, as a church. We are all in this liminal space, in big ways and in small ones, together.

Sheryl Fullerton, an editor and author, speaks of the destabilization and disorientation that we find - mentally, physically, emotionally, and spiritually – in liminal space and imagines that, despite our deep discomfort and urge to pass through it as quickly as possible, we might discover in it "a place and state of creativity, of construction and deconstruction, choice and transformation." I have been reflecting on the opportunities that are opening up in this time for me, personally, for the Church universal, and for Centre Church. I don't have specific answers at the moment. Even though this "shut-down" of life as we knew it seems to have been going on forever already, it truly has been but a tiny wrinkle in time so far. So, for once, I am content not to try to control it. Instead, I am attempting to stay open to whatever new life might be found for us all. How about you? Can you see your way to sitting beside me in it and waiting?

I've heard much mention of the positive impact the slowing of life is having on our planet. I hope that means we will embrace the clearing of our vision, both literally and figuratively. Can you hear Johnny Nash singing "I Can See Clearly Now?" [listen here:

https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=FscIgtDJFXg I pray we might keep our eyes open to what is coming into focus for us personally and communally. God, our Creator and Comforter, God our Shepherd, God our Advocate did not create this pandemic. But I believe that God can use it for good if we allow ourselves to be led. I believe we can and must harness its potential for good by tuning in and seeing what it has to teach us. Are you open to new possibilities?

Dear friends, I know this is an incredibly difficult and challenging time. I see the ripples of grief, loss, sadness, loneliness, and struggle moving through our lives. We did not jump into this liminal space of our own accord but were literally pushed off the cliff by this pandemic. However, there is new life beyond the crosses we bear and the tombs that try to hold us. I am not asking you to ignore your feelings or the feelings of others — and this pandemic sure is serving up a smorgasbord of feelings — I am asking you instead to feel everything honestly but allow yourself to wonder what you might learn from your feelings, your true experience in this liminal space, for yourself and for all of us.
