### **Good Friday**

As I grapple with all that has happened over the last two years, I find myself more and evermore in need of time in silent meditation. Whether that time is spent walking outside, letting nature be the song I'm hearing, or inside on my cushion meditating, I find that my ability to be present to the daily joys and sorrows is greatly enhanced by these deeply prayerful moments. And so, as I contemplated Holy Week and the opportunities we offer for our walk to the cross with Jesus, I decided that I really need Good Friday. I need time dedicated to silent prayer and reflection, and corporate worship. Maybe you do, too.

On Good Friday, April 15, our sanctuary will be open from 12:00 - 2:00 pm for prayer and meditation. There will be opportunities for ritual interaction with the story of Jesus' final hours of life. There will be a visual liturgy that will play every half hour that will lead you through a series of three anointings.

Then from 2:00 – 3:00 pm we will share a worship experience offered by the Southern New England Conference of the UCC. <u>Good Friday: Engaging the Passion of Christ and the Environmental Crisis will</u> be shown in the sanctuary. This program was developed by Rev. Emma Brewer-Wallin, Minister for Environmental and Economic Justice, and Rev. Liz Garrigan-Byerly, ACM for the North Central Region. It will feature music by the Willie Sordillo Ensemble.

I hope in these offerings an opportunity to connect the Passion of Christ to your life in the world today.




### Easter Sunday, April 17






### **Altar Flowers**
