Taking Attendance

As I have been preparing for a new church year, I have been more intentional in noticing what is grabbing my attention. There is no end of "TO DO" lists and tasks on them, but often I learn most about myself when I notice where my attention goes. By this I don't mean being self-critical, as in, "I'm doing X when I should be doing Y," but rather being curious, "I wonder why I'm drawn to this particular article, task, endeavor?" I pray you can notice what is capturing your attention and interrogate that a bit. Is it something that adds to your life or something that is stealing your precious attention? No matter what in your life is calling for your attention, I hope you'll

commit to praying about your attendance and participation in Centre Church and share what you know, what you learn, and what you hope for. Any ONE of us can lead us toward the people and situations that most need our love and attention. Maybe even you! Toward this new beginning we go together. Thanks be to our God with whom all things are possible!
